EXHIBITOR RULES & REGULATIONS

- All Animals must be registered with their appropriate Breed Society; respective Herd Book of Societies in Australia and exhibitors will abide by their breed rules and ethics of showing.
- Handlers must not be under the influence of alcohol and/or illicit drugs on show day.
- Age of the exhibits will be taken as at the date of the show.
- All Females over the age of 9 months must be led by a nose grip.
- All Bulls 9-12 months of age must be led by a nose grip/ring.
- All Bulls over the age of 12 months must be led by a ring through the nose.
- No bull 2 yrs and over to be let by person under 18 yrs of age.
- All Cattle are to be tethered by a halter and also secured by a neck strap.
- All Calves at foot must be under 9 months of age on the day of the show.
- Calves at foot must be the natural progeny of the Dam & Sire and eligible for registration of the Breed Society of the Dam & Sire.
- The Society reserves the right to substitute prize money and trophies for cash.
- The Chief Steward reserves the right to withdraw or deny an entry at their discretion.
- All Cattle must have NLIS ear tags.
- At this stage no power is connected and recommended exhibitors provide their own generators.
- **Cattle Exhibitors either sign the waiver provided or must provide a copy of their Certificate of Currency.**

Summary

The livestock competitions are grouped together as they follow a two-step process to selecting a State Winner.

For the Beef and Dairy Cattle competitions the first two place getters (e.g. 1st and 2nd) at a local show/field day are invited to attend the State Finals.

All Judging Competitions are conducted according to the Federal Council of Agricultural Societies Guidelines which can be found on the FCAS website.

State Final

Rules and Regulations for Livestock competitions

1. Competitors must be aged between 15 and 25 years on the 1st May in the year of the State Final
2. State Final winners to represent the State at National Final level
3. The Hormel Slide is to be used at all National Finals
4. National Final winners are ineligible to compete again in the particular class that they won

Prizes for the State Finals

First: Trophy and Sash

Second: Sash

Third: Sash

The winner of each State Final will be invited to participate in the Federal Council of Agricultural Societies (FCAS) National Finals in the year following the State Final. The National Finals are held on a rotation basis by the host state, date and time to be determined.

Please note: Handlers under 15 years must only parade heifers up to the age of 24 months in this competition. No bulls are permitted in Class YP1 & YP2.

Entry Free and lodged with your normal entries or on the day

Prize Money or Trophy TBA: 1st 2nd 3rd 4th

Class YP1: Under 10 years

Class YP2: 10 and under 15 years

Class YP3: VAS Ltd 15 and under 25 years (by 1st May in year final held)
